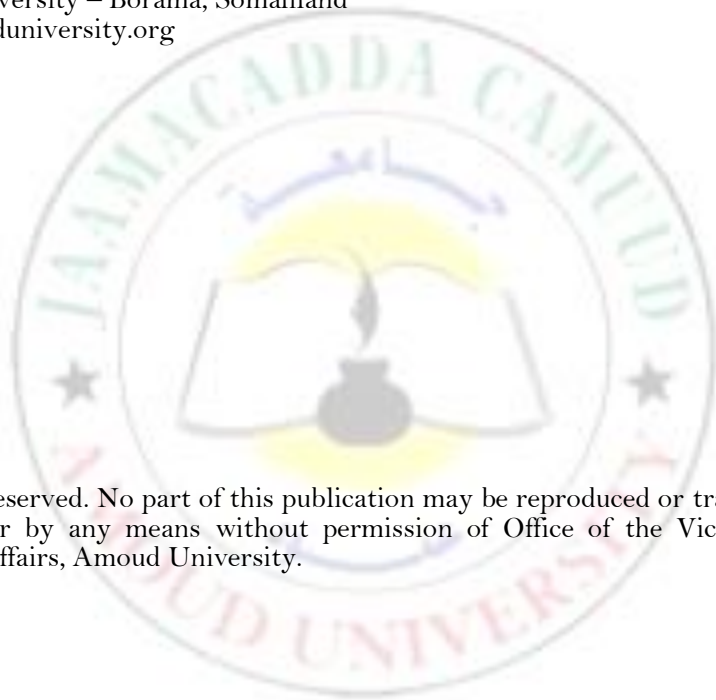

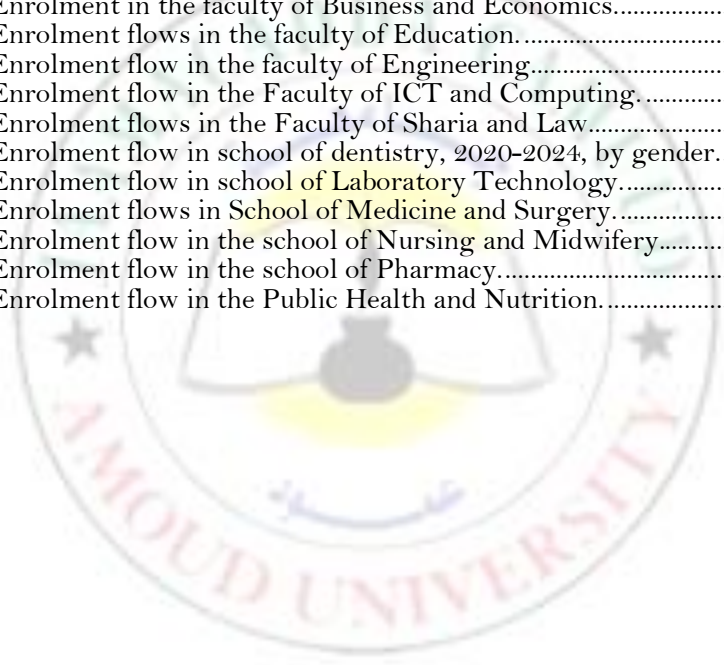

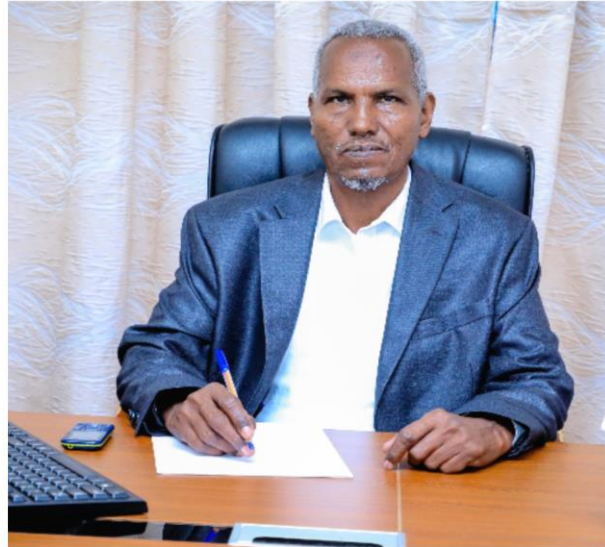

1.0 Brief History and Background

Following the collapse of the Somali state in 1991 and the civil strife which ensued, educational facilities were destroyed, damaged and some were simply abandoned due to insecurity. Education ceased to function at all levels, and the future of all school-going-age children and youth throughout Somalia was suddenly blocked by circumstances beyond their control. Thousands of students' education was interrupted and the students were released into the market without the necessary qualifications to enter the job market. In response to this bleak situation, a group of Somali professionals in Somaliland and the Diaspora met in 1996 and meditated on the creation of an institution of higher learning. This culminated in the establishment of Amoud University as a community-based educational establishment.

Amoud University was formally registered in November 4, 1998 as a non-governmental, non-profit making institution. The University started with 66 students in two faculties (Education and Business Administration), and three (3) teachers. To date, the University has 4,354 students enrolled in 14 teaching units, and over 266 teachers, and will confer 1,087 undergraduate, postgraduate degrees and doctoral degrees and certificates in various fields. The University is deeply rooted in the local community, and her primary support comes from the community elders, leaders, business people, concerned citizens and local non-governmental organizations. Establishment of Amoud University is a symbol of transition from an era of war and destruction to an era of peace and development. It has inspired other communities in Somaliland and indeed in other Somalia regions to start providing higher education along the ethos of Amoud University.

Amoud University actively participates in national development; working in close consultation with the public and the private sector institutions to improve the socio-economic well-being of the national populace. It endeavors to develop the necessary human capital through continuous design of market-sensitive programmes that enhance sustainable national economic growth and development in areas that are necessary and critical to accelerated progress towards achievement of holistic development.

1.2 Statements of Purposes of Amoud University

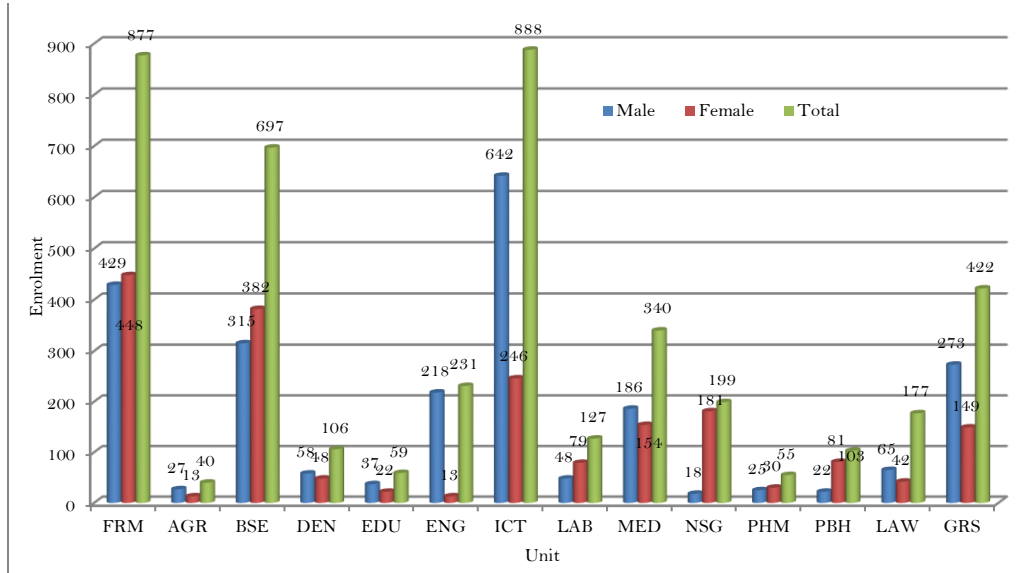


Figure 1. Overall enrolment, 2024/2025, by faculty/school.

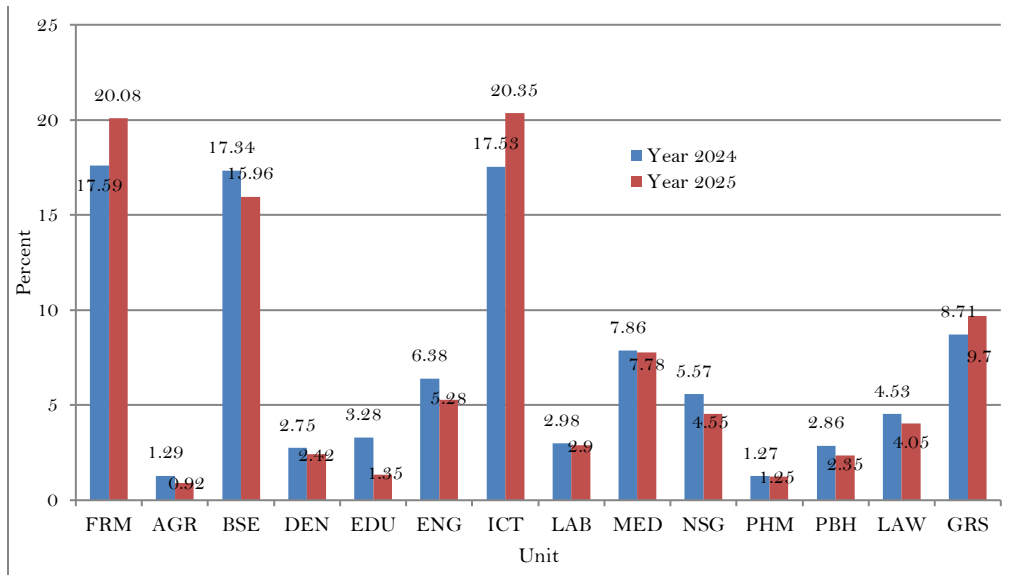


Figure 2. Percentage enrolment, 2024/2025, by faculty/school.

Freshman department has the highest enrolment (877, 20.08%) because it hosts all students admitted in year 1 (freshman) of study before they are placed into specific programmes of study. Overall enrolment of male students is 2,380 (54.66%) against enrolment of female students of 1,974 (45.34%) for the 2024/2025 academic year. The overall enrolment of male students decreased by 339 (12.46%) while the enrollment of female students decreased by 82 (3.98%). The total enrollment decreased by 364 (7.71%) as compared to the 2023/2024 academic year.

Only 3 units registered positive deviations in enrolment: freshman 2.49%, ICT 2.78% and graduate school 0.99%. The rest 9 units all registered negative enrolment deviations.

3.2.2 Total Graduates Turnover, 1997-2024

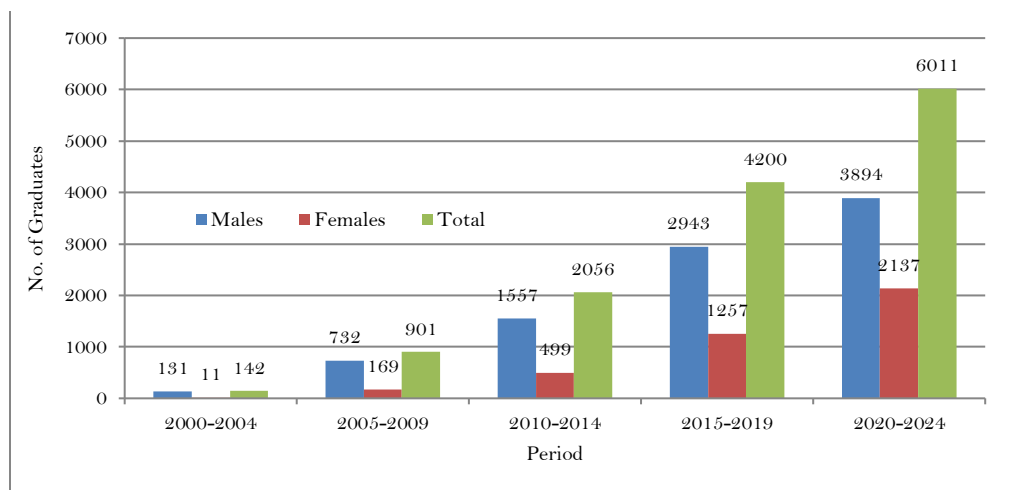


Figure 3. Overall graduate turnover, 2000-2024 by gender.

Since 1997, Amoud University has enrolled and graduated 13,319 students in various fields. Each year, the University graduates an increased number of qualified students for various fields of specialization as summarized in Table 4 and Figure 3.

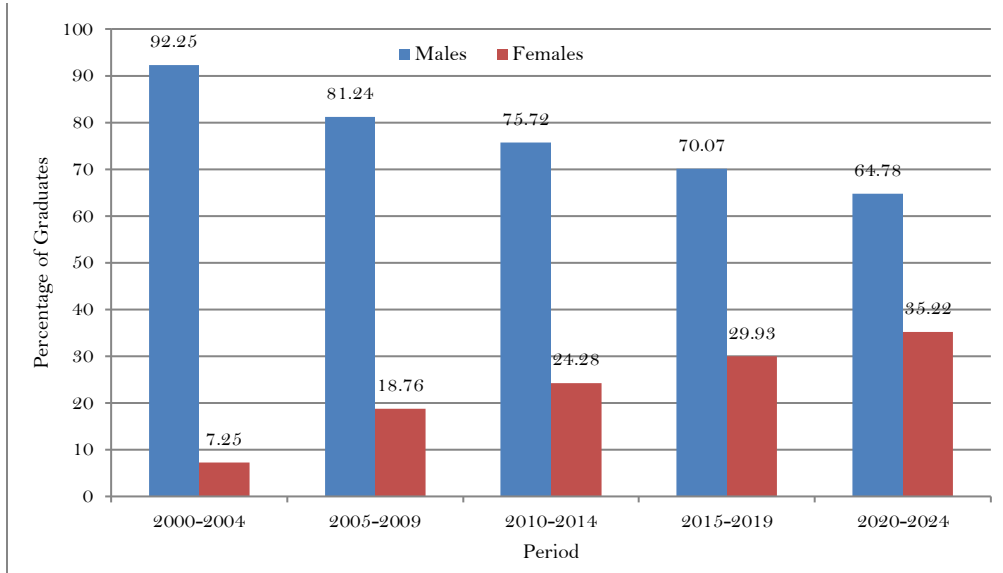


Figure 4. Proportion of graduates, 2000-2024, by gender.

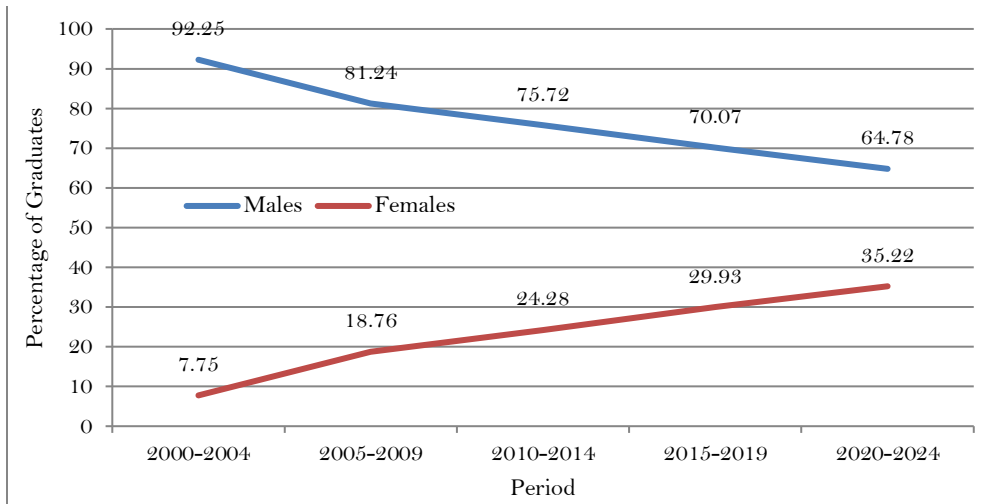


Figure 5. Proportion flows of graduates, 2000-2024, by gender.

As depicted in Figure 4 and Figure 5, the proportion of males graduating has been higher than that of female throughout all graduation points. However, the proportion of females graduating has consistently increased through time. Amoud University has taken affirmative action to ensure that the enrolment and retention of female students is improved in all programmes. While only 7.75% of graduating students in 2000-2004 were females, the proportion has increased to 35.22% in 2020-2024, an increase of 27.47 percentage points, or 1.09% per year.

The proportion of male graduates increased by 2,872.52% over the 2000-2024 period, or by 114.90% per year over the period. Therefore, while the number of male graduating has been higher than the number of female graduating at each point, the

proportion of female graduating has been increasing at a higher rate than that of males. Between 2000-2024, on average, the number of graduates increased by 5,869, an increase of (4,133.09%, or 165.32% per year).

The proportion of male graduates decreased consistently by 27.47 percentage points or by 1.09% per year while the proportion of female graduates increased by the same percentage points per year (1.09%).

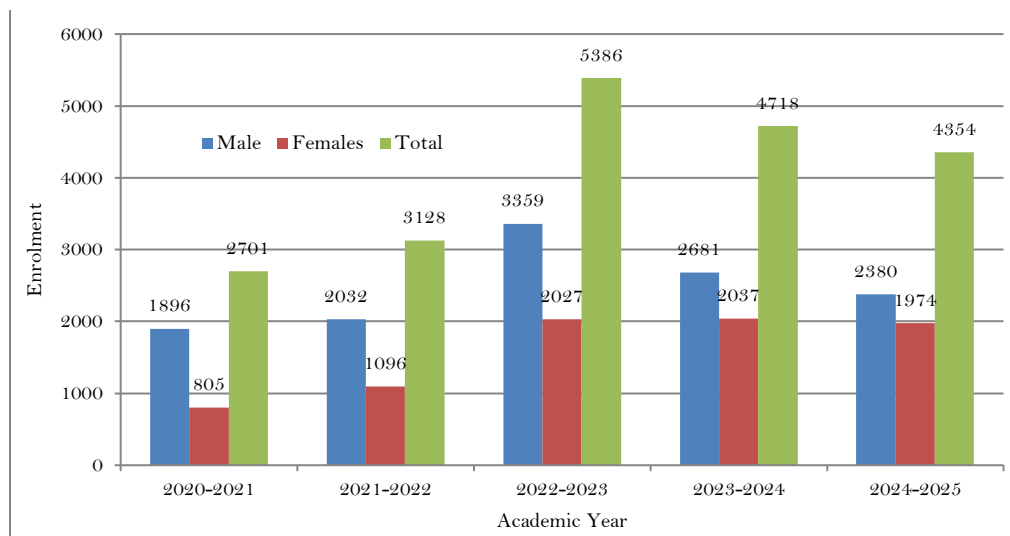


Figure 6. Overall enrolment, 2020-2024, by gender.

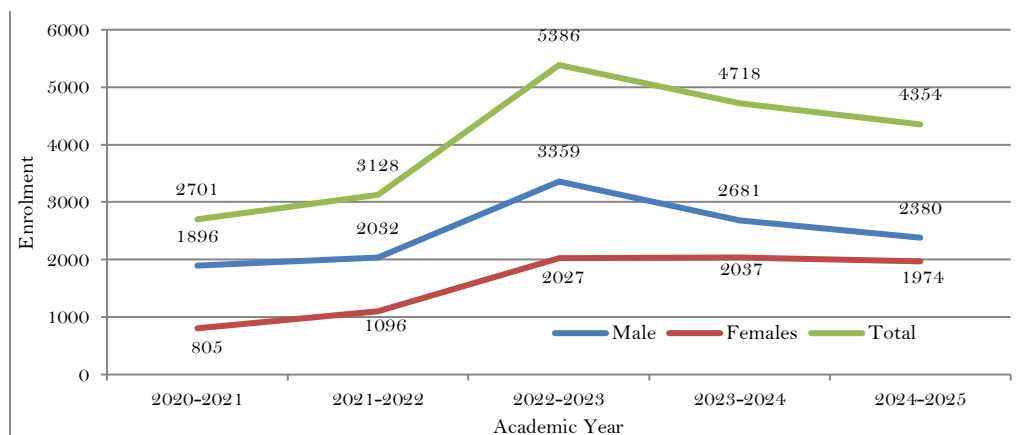


Figure 7. Overall enrolment flows, 2020-2024, by gender.

For the 2020-2024 period, the enrolment of male students increased by 745 from 1,896 to 2,380, and the enrolment of female students increased by 1,169 from 805 to 1,974. The enrolment flow is depicted in Figure 7.

Over the 2020-2024 period, enrolment of male students increased by 25.52% or by 5.10% per year while the enrolment of female students increased by 145.22% or by 29.04% per year. Over the period, total student enrolment increased by 61.19%, or by 12.23% per year.

While the enrolment of male students has been higher than of female students by about 52.80 percentage points per year (male students = 76.74% and female students = 24.06%) at all points, on average, the female students has increased at a higher rate (28.38%) as compared to male students (7.69%).

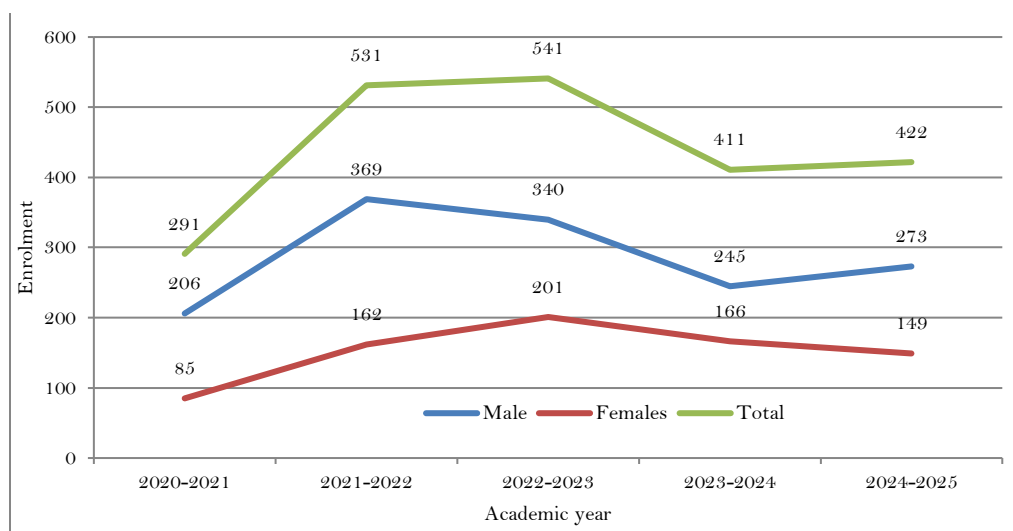


Figure 8. Postgraduate enrolment flows, 2020-2024, by gender.

Over the 2020-2024 period, the enrolment of male students in the postgraduate programmes increased by 32.52% or by 6.50% per year, while the enrolment of female students in the postgraduate programmes increased by 110.34% or by 15.05% per year over the period. The total enrolment in the postgraduate school increased by 45.02% or by 9.00% per year, over the same period. While the enrolment of male students was generally higher than of female students by about 24.97 percentage points on average (male students = 65.48%, female students = 40.51%), on average, the females' enrolment rate was higher than male students' enrolment rate by about 24.97 percentage points.

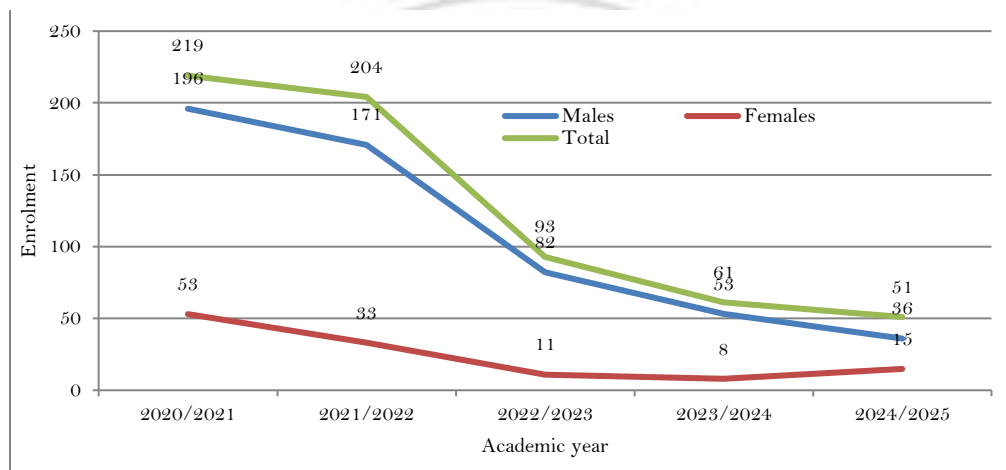


Figure 9. Enrolment flow in the faculty of Agriculture and Environment, 2020-2024, by gender by year.

Over the 2020-2024 period, the enrolment of male students in the faculty of agriculture and environment decreased by 81.63% or by 16.32% per year, while the enrolment of female students in the faculty decreased by 71.69% or by 14.33% per year over the period. The overall enrolment in the faculty of Agriculture and Environment decreased by 75.57% (14.71% per year) over the 2020-2024 period. Over the period, the faculty of Agriculture and Environment enrolled 628 students, 538 (55.66%) male students and 120 (14.34%) female students.

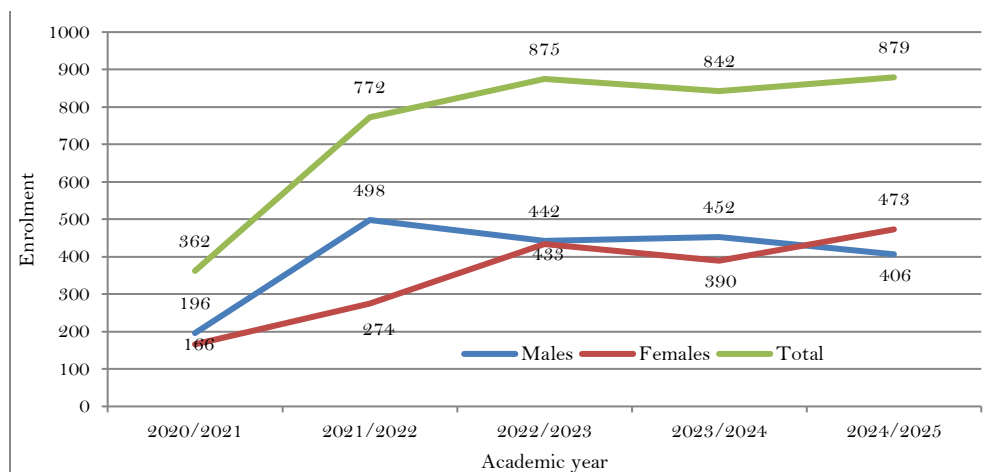


Figure 10. Enrolment in the faculty of Business and Economics, 2020-2024, by gender.

The gross enrolment of male students in the faculty of Business and Economics over the 2020-2024 period increased by 1.0% or by 0.2% per year while the enrolment of female students increased by 48.17%, or by 9.6% per year. The overall enrolment in the faculty of Business and Economics increased by 19.94% (3.98% per year). Over the period 2020-2024, the faculty of Business and Economics enrolled 3,910 students, 1,994 (50.99%) male students and 1,736 (49.01%) females.

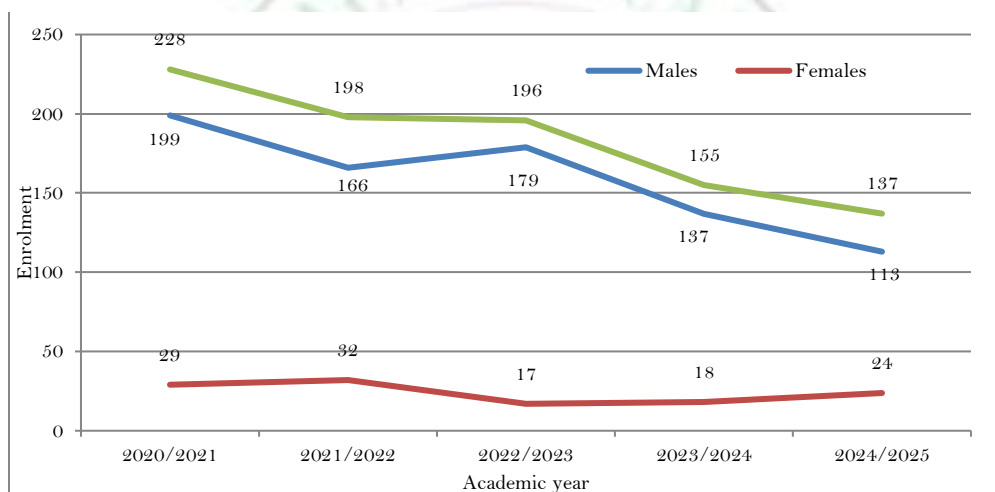


Figure 11. Enrolment flows in the faculty of education, 2020-2024, by gender.

Generally, the total enrolment of male students in Faculty of Education for the 2020-2024 period decreased by 43.20% or by 8.6% per year while the total enrolment of female students decreased by 17.2% over the period, or by 3.4% per year. The net enrolment for all students in all programmes decreased by 39.9% over the period, or by 7.9% per year. Over the 2020-2024 period, the Faculty of Education enrolled 910 students, 794 (87.25%) males and 120 (12.75%) females.

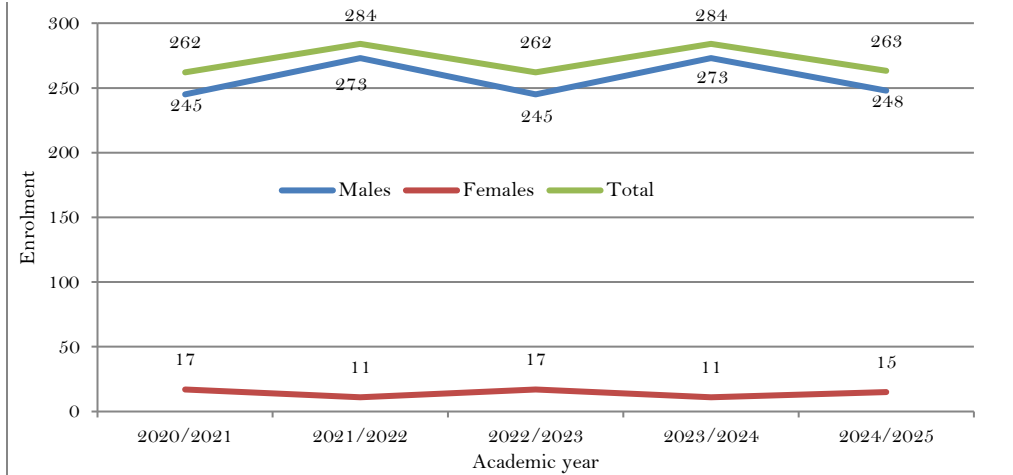


Figure 12. Enrolment flow in the faculty of engineering, 2020-2024, by gender.

The Faculty of Engineering registered a fluctuating enrolment over the 2020-2024 period. The overall enrolment of males students in the faculty of Engineering increased by 1.22% over the period, or by 0.24% per year while the enrolment of female students decreased by 11.7% or by 2.3% per year. The overall students' enrolment in the faculty increased by just 0.38% over the period, or by 0.08% per year. Over the 2020-2024 period, the Faculty of Engineering enrolled 1,355 students, 1,284 (97.76%) male students and 71 (2.24%) females.

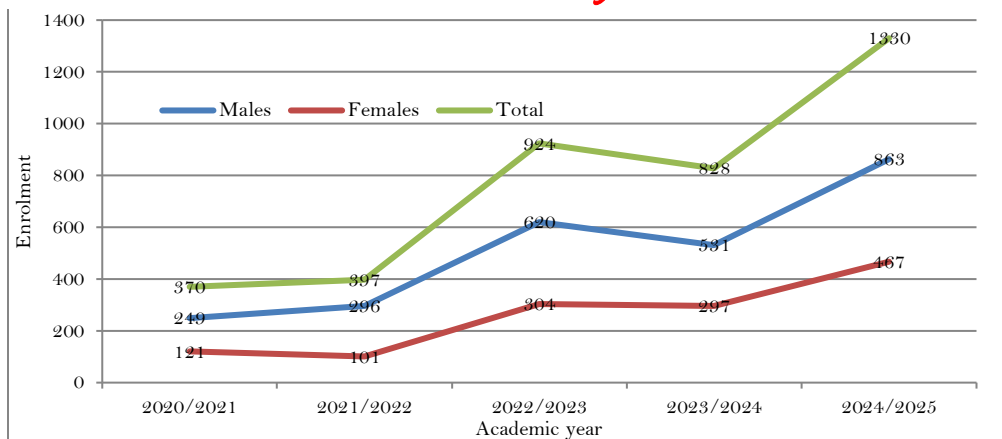


Figure 13. Enrolment flow in the Faculty of ICT and Computing, 2020-2024, by gender.

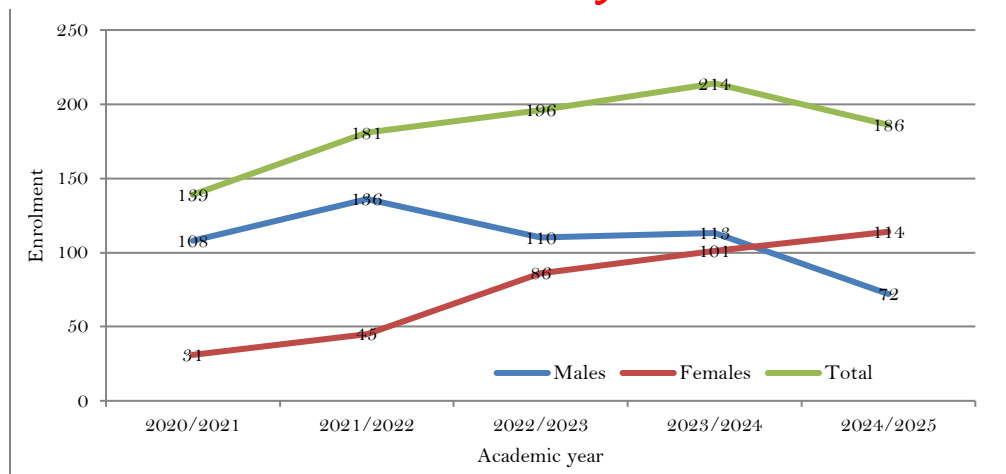


Figure 14. Enrolment flows in the Faculty of Sharia and Law, 2020-2024, by gender.

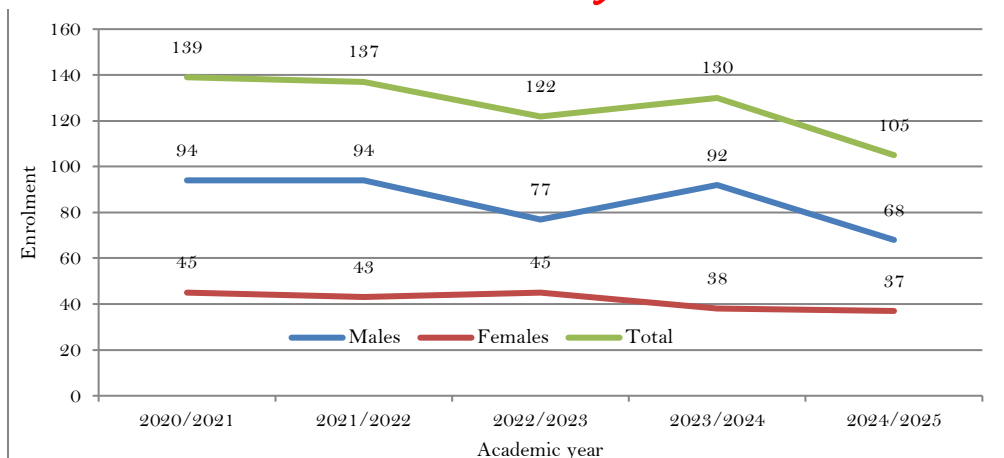


Figure 15. Enrolment flow in school of dentistry, 2020-2024, by gender.

The School of Dentistry registered a decreased enrolment of male students but a slight increased enrolment of female students over the 2020-2024 period. 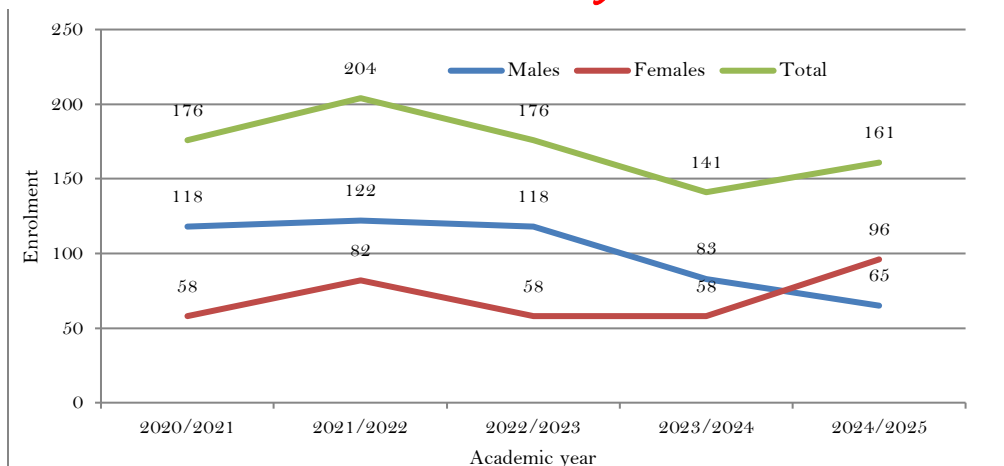


Figure 16. Enrolment flow in school of laboratory technology, 2020-2024, by year and gender.

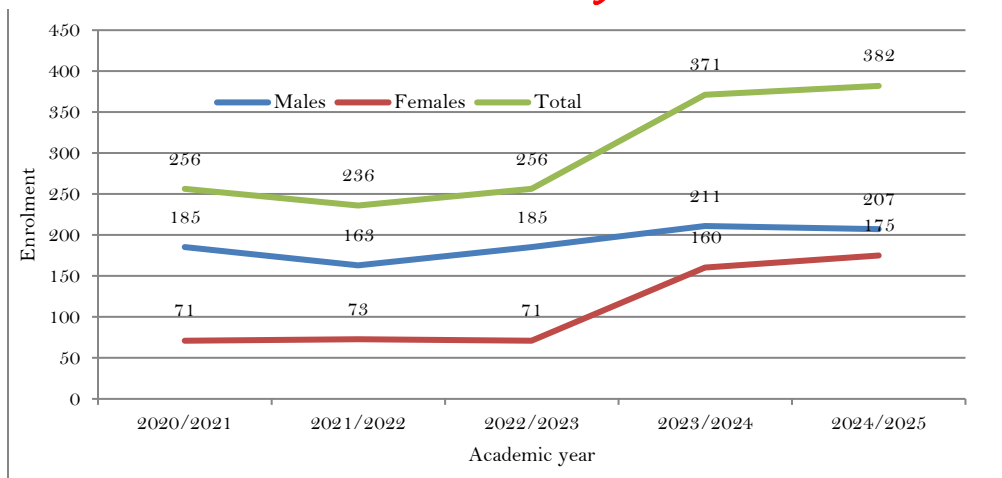


Figure 17. Enrolment flows in School of Medicine and Surgery, 2020-2024, by year and gender.

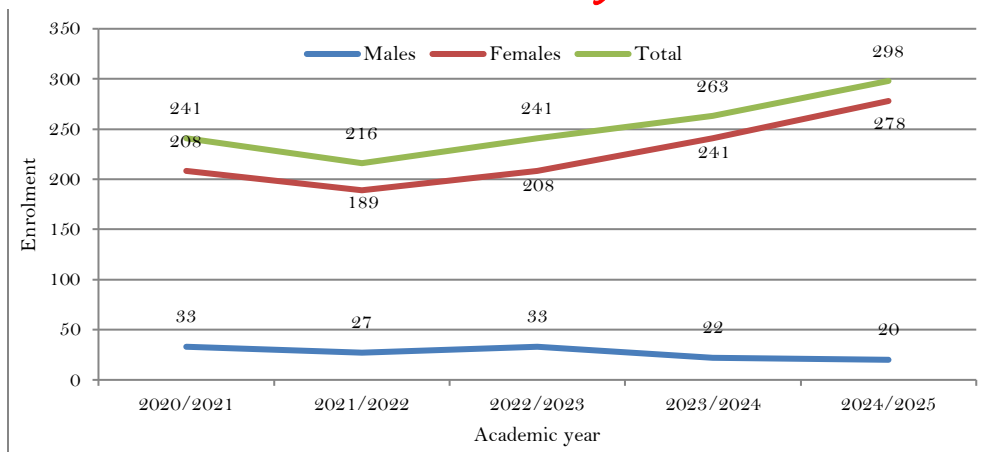


Figure 18. Enrolment flow in the school of nursing and midwifery, 2020-2024, by year and gender.

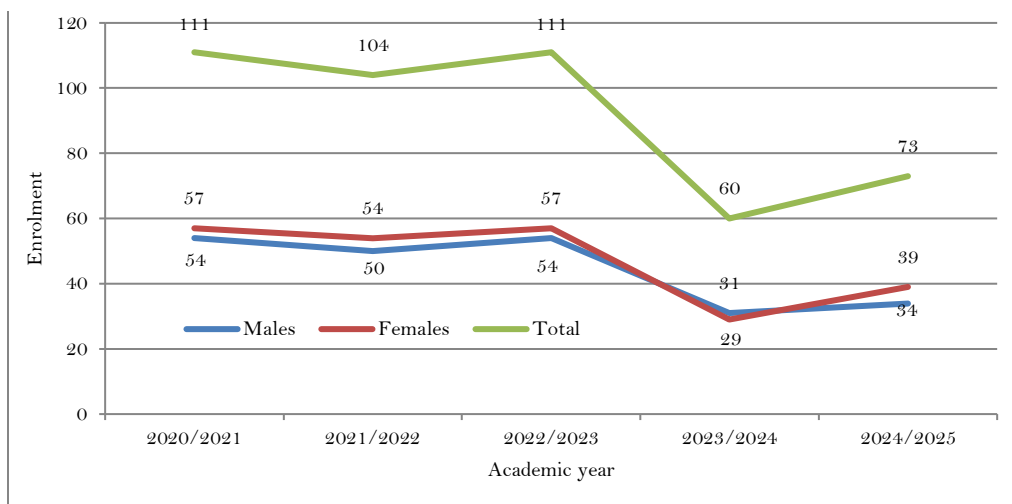


Figure 19. Enrolment flow in the school of pharmacy, 2020-2024, by gender.

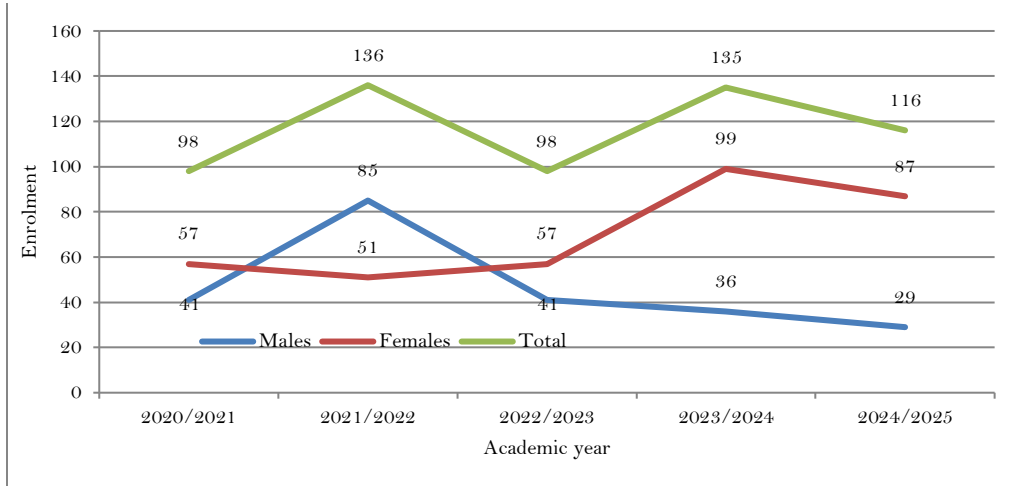


Figure 20. Enrolment flow in the Public Health and Nutrition, 2020-2024, by gender.
